## TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

### Visa Requirements

Saints travelling from countries outside of West Africa and some parts of Central Africa may require a Visa. Some citizens of the African Union (AU) states that are not part of the ECOWAS can apply for a Visa on arrival. Kindly click [here](#) for further details. For any further enquiries, **kindly check with your local consulate.**

Passports should have at least 6 months' validity.

### Vaccination Requirements

Mandatory: Yellow Fever

Recommended: Hepatitis A, Typhoid, Hepatitis B, Meningitis, and Polio, depending on your individual risk. It is also recommended to consult with your medical specialist six weeks before your trip to discuss the necessary precautions and any recommended malaria prophylaxis, as Ghana has a high risk of malaria.

It is best to consult with the following sources before traveling:

- The Embassy or High Commission of Ghana in your country of residence.
- Your local travel health clinic, which can provide advice tailored to your specific travel plans and health history.

### Declarations

Travellers must declare any hard currency exceeding USD 10,000 at customs upon arrival.

### TRANSPORTATION

The Anagkazo Campus is 37km from the Kotoka International Airport. There is a bus/coach arrangement to transport brethren who arrive at the airport to Anagkazo **at a fee.**

There are also ride-hailing services (Uber and Bolt) available. A ride from the airport to the Anagkazo may range between USD 15 and USD 20.

There is also a car hire option for brethren who may want to drive in Ghana with an international driving licence (IDL). The car hire price ranges between USD 56/day and USD 150/day, depending on the type of car.

To get an International Driving Permit (IDP) for use in Ghana, you must apply to an official IDP provider, such as IDP Globe, IDA Service, or E-ITA, by submitting a copy of your national driver's license, a passport-sized photo, and completing an online application form. These providers will process your application and send you both a digital and a physical copy of the IDP, which allows you to drive legally in Ghana. Existing holders of the IDL can drive in Ghana, provided it is valid.

### OTHER INFORMATION

#### Payments

The Ghana Cedi is the generally accepted currency for transactions. However, all major currencies can be easily exchanged at any forex bureau. Debit cards (Visa and Mastercard) are accepted in many places. Credit cards may be accepted in certain locations.
